


TEMPORARY CHANGE IN DRINKING WATER TREATMENT PROCESS



DURING NTMWD'S ANNUAL, 28-DAY TEMPORARY CHANGE IN DISINFECTANT:



AMMONIA IS REMOVED FROM THE DISINFECTION PROCESS. WITHOUT AMMONIA, THE CHLORINE IN THE WATER MAY BE MORE NOTICEABLE, BUT THE AMOUNT IS CONSISTENT WITH LEVELS YEAR ROUND.



FLUSHING FROM FIRE HYDRANTS
CAN BE AN IMPORTANT PART OF
MAINTAINING THE WATER SYSTEM
AND HIGH WATER QUALITY. CITIES
MAY FLUSH TO MOVE WATER
THROUGH PIPES MORE QUICKLY.



TESTING IS CONTINUALLY
CONDUCTED THROUGHOUT TO
ENSURE WATER QUALITY.
